# Could your child be entitled to additional funding to support their learning?

We want to make sure that we are providing your child with the best education and support we can.

In our school, if your child is entitled to Pupil Premium funding, we receive additional financial support from Central Government, which we use to purchase specialist services and additional resources for your child and our school.

The following information will help you establish whether you qualify.

# Who can get Pupil Premium funding (sometimes referred to as Free School Meals funding)?

All pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 in primary schools are entitled to 'universal' free school meals. This is not the same as 'Free School Meals' (FSM). Pupils who are eligible for FSM receive additional funding called 'Pupil Premium'.

The pupil premium means that even if you don't wish for your child to access a free hot meal at school each day, being eligible will mean that our school will receive further funding. This means you can get extra financial support with other aspects of school life, not just a free school meal and can be used to support eligible pupils with their learning and can help towards the cost of school visits, buying educational equipment and with the purchasing of school uniform.

Your child is eligible for free school meals if you're in receipt of certain benefits, please refer to the attached application form for more details.

## **How to Claim**

If you think your family could qualify, please complete the attached form and return it to the school. Alternatively if you have any questions or would like to speak to Mr Jowett or another member of our staff team in complete confidence, please do not hesitate to get in contact. #### APPLYING FOR FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Families who receive certain benefits may be eligible for free school meals. Your child is eligible for free school meals if you're in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- o Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400.
- o Income Support
- o Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- o Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- o The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190

Registering for free meals could also raise extra funds for your child's primary school which helps provide additional resources and services

This additional money is available from central government for every child whose parent is receiving one of the benefits listed above.

To check if your child is eligible, we need information about you and your child. Please complete this form and return to your child's school.
